I. INTRODUCTION

WELCOME TO JILIN AGRICULTURAL UNIVERSITY

Located in Changchun, the capital city of Jilin Province, Jilin Agricultural University is a key university of Jilin Province. The People's Government of Jilin Province cooperates with the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs to build a university. The first batch of universities under the Ministry of Education and the State Administration of Foreign Experts Affairs ("111" Program). The first batch of 50 "national innovation and entrepreneurship typical experience universities", the first batch of national deepening innovation and entrepreneurship education reform demonstration universities, the first batch of scientific and technological achievements transformation and technology transfer bases of the Ministry of Education. After 76 years of construction and development, it has become a key provincial university with strengths and characteristics in agriculture and life sciences, offering a coordinated development of multiple disciplines including agriculture, science, engineering, medicine, liberal arts, management, law, education, economics, and art. It serves as an irreplaceable and crucial base for talent cultivation, scientific and technological innovation, and extension services for national and regional agricultural and rural development.

The university comprises 23 colleges, one directly affiliated teaching department, and one graduate school. It is among the first batch of universities in China authorized to award bachelor's and master's degrees and was the earliest provincial university to be authorized to award doctoral degrees. JLAU offers 11 first-level disciplines authorized to award doctoral degrees, two categories of professional doctoral degrees, and nine postdoctoral research stations; 23 first-level disciplines authorized to award master's degrees and 15 categories of professional master's degrees. It has one national key (cultivated) discipline, three key disciplines at ministerial level, 13 provincial high-level characteristic disciplines, and two disciplines approved for the "World-Class Discipline Development Plan of Jilin Province." Seven disciplines, including Plant & Animal Science, Agricultural Science, Chemistry, Pharmacology & Toxicology, Environmental & Ecological Science, Biology & Biochemistry, and Microbiology, have entered the top 1% of the ESI global rankings.

Currently, the university has 1,791 faculty members, including one National Teaching Master, 28 recipients of national major talent programs (projects), 35 experts receiving special allowances from the State Council, six nationally recognized young and middle-aged experts with outstanding contributions, seven candidates selected for the national "Million Talent Project," seven New Century Excellent Talents selected by the Ministry of Education, and two leading young and middle-aged scientific and technological innovators selected by the Ministry of Science and Technology. There are six members of the Discipline Evaluation Panel of the Academic Degrees Committee of the State Council, and eight members of the Higher Education Teaching Steering Committee under the Ministry of Education. There are 27 senior experts in Jilin Province, seven distinguished professors specially appointed by the "Changbai Mountain Scholars" program in Jilin Province, 53 young and middle-aged experts with outstanding contributions in Jilin Province, 66 top-notch innovative talents in Jilin Province, and three counselors to the Jilin Provincial Government. JLAU also has one "Cheung-Kong Scholars Innovation Team" recognized by the Ministry of Education, one national excellent teaching team, two national "Huang Danian Style Teacher Teams," three "Huang Danian Style Teacher Teams" and one "Huang Danian Style Research Team" at the provincial level. In 2018, it was approved as a "National Expert Service Base."

Currently, JLAU has 25,015 full-time students, including 19,648 undergraduates, 4,673 master's students, 637 doctoral students, in addition to 10,317 registered correspondence students. The university offers 72 undergraduate majors, including 15 national first-class undergraduate majors, seven national characteristic majors, two national pilot majors for comprehensive reform, 21 provincial first-class undergraduate majors, 15 provincial high-level characteristic majors, 13 provincial characteristic majors, nine provincial brand majors, and six provincial pilot majors for the "Excellent Engineer Education and Training Program." The university also has one national modern industrial college among the first batch of such colleges, two provincial modern industrial colleges, one national characteristic college under cultivation, one provincial characteristic college, one pilot project for national virtual teaching and

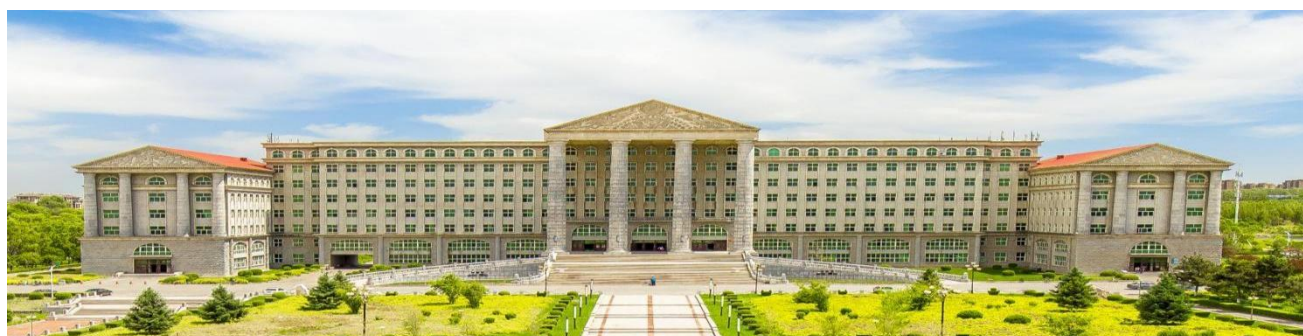
research offices among the first batch of such offices, three excellent grassroots teaching organizations of universities in Jilin, three provincial bases for cultivating top students in basic disciplines, three provincial off-campus practice bases for agriculture-study integrated education, four off-campus practice teaching bases for cultivating excellent talents in universities, and 499 practice teaching bases of various types. JLAU has 16 national first-class undergraduate courses, one national ideological and political education demonstration course, 52 provincial first-class undergraduate courses (five types of "golden courses"), and six provincial ideological and political education demonstration courses. Three textbooks have been funded by the National Agricultural Education Excellent Textbook Program, seven textbooks have been approved as projects in the "14th Five-Year Plan" of the National Forestry and Grassland Administration, seven textbooks have been approved as key textbook projects by the Education Department of Jilin Province, and 28 textbooks have been approved as projects in the "14th Five-Year Plan" of the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Affairs. The university has twice received an "Excellent" rating in the undergraduate teaching evaluation conducted by the Ministry of Education and passed the undergraduate teaching assessment in 2016. In recent years, JLAU has been the first among universities in Jilin Province to implement cross-major category enrollment and cultivation reform and has been approved as a demonstration university for talent cultivation reform in Jilin Province (Category A). The university has deeply promoted the construction of new agricultural science as the focus of the "Four New Constructions" Initiative, been approved with eight research and reform practice projects of the "Four New Constructions" Initiative by the Ministry of Education and one experimental teaching and teaching laboratory construction and research project by the Ministry of Education, established the Jilin Province New Agricultural Science Changbai Mountain Innovation Institute, successfully hosted the National New Agricultural Science Construction Work Promotion Conference, and created the collaborative education model for new agricultural science construction known as the "Jilin Model". The university has been consecutively won a second award for national higher education teaching achievements for two sessions and received one special award for provincial higher education teaching achievements. Over the years, the employment rate of its graduates has consistently been among the top in universities across the province.

JLAU has 33 research platforms at national and ministerial levels, including the Innovation and Talent Introduction Base for Exploration, Creation, and Application of High-Quality, High-Yield, and Disease-Resistant Germplasm Resources of Fungus Crops, the Innovation and Talent Introduction Base for Northeast Characteristic Resources and Health Food, the International Research Center for Development of New Fungus Germplasm Resources, the National Engineering Research Center for Wheat and Corn Deep Processing, the National and Local Joint Engineering Research Center for Selection and Development of New Ginseng Varieties, the National and Local Joint Engineering Research Center for Economic Fungus Research and Utilization, the Key Laboratory of Animal Production and Product Quality Safety under the Ministry of Education, the Key Laboratory of Straw Comprehensive Utilization and Black Soil Protection under the Ministry of Education, the International Cooperative Laboratory of Modern Agricultural Technology under the Ministry of Education, the National Crop Germplasm Resources Changchun Observation and Experiment Station, and the National Crop Variety Evaluation and Characteristic Identification Station, in addition to 89 provincial research platforms. Since the launch of "14th Five-Year Plan," JLAU has undertaken 1,750 research projects with a total research funding of 792 million yuan. In 2023, the university won the first prize of the National Scientific and Technological Progress Award, marking a breakthrough for provincial universities in Jilin Province to win the first prize of the national scientific and technological award. It has received 90 awards at provincial and ministerial levels, ranking first among provincial universities for consecutive years in terms of the number and quality of provincial scientific and technological awards. JLAU has published 2,225 academic papers in high-level journals both domestically and internationally, such as *Science*, *Microbiome* and *Guangming Daily*. The university sponsors four professional academic journals, among which *Journal of Jilin Agricultural University*, *Journal of Economic Animal*, and *Journal of Fungal Research* are selected as China's Excellent Scientific and Technological Journals, included in the Scopus database, and listed as core journals in the Chinese Science Citation Database (CSCD), Chinese Core Journals, China's Science and Technology Core Journals, and Agriculture and Forestry Core Journals. The *Journal of Home Economics* is

the first academic journal on home economics in China. JLAU actively fulfills its social service functions and has established strategic partnerships with more than 60 local governments and enterprises. It has established a number of characteristic rural revitalization demonstration service bases such as rural revitalization experimental stations, school-local-enterprise R&D centers, and technology stations across China, forming a technology service system marked by the "Antu Model" of cooperation with local entities, the "Minle Model" of cooperation with villages, the "Borui Model" of cooperation with enterprises, the "Haotian Model" for targeted poverty alleviation, the "Jingyu Model" for technological assistance and support, and the "Zambia Model" for international cooperation. These efforts have generated a cumulative technical income of over 18 billion yuan and made the university one of the first batch of winners of the Provincial Government's Awards for Contributions to the Commercialization of Scientific and Technological Achievements. The university has jointly established the first Jilin Rural Revitalization Research Institute with the Provincial Department of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, and co-founded the Jilin Provincial Rural Revitalization Academy with the Provincial Department of Agriculture and Rural Affairs, the Provincial Department of Human Resources and Social Security, the Provincial Department of Education, and the Provincial Rural Revitalization Bureau. Additionally, it has collaborated with the Jilin Provincial Federation of Trade Unions and the Changchun Federation of Trade Unions to establish the Jilin Provincial New Agricultural Craftsman College and the Changchun Rural Craftsman College, providing crucial intellectual support for the modernization of agriculture and rural areas in the new era. The university's poverty alleviation model was recognized by the Ministry of Education as one of the "Top 20 Typical Cases of Targeted Poverty Alleviation and Eradication among Provincial Universities Nationwide". Academician Li Yu from the university was honored with the title of "Poverty Alleviation Role Model" and received an award from General Secretary Xi Jinping at the National Summary and Commendation Conference on Poverty Alleviation.

The university adheres to open education and has established inter-university exchange and cooperation with 98 universities and institutions from 31 countries and regions, including the United States, Italy, and Zambia. It is a Chinese member institution of the "China-Africa Hundred Universities Cooperation Plan," a council member of the "Belt and Road South-South Cooperation Agricultural Education, Science, and Technology Innovation Alliance," the vice president unit of the China-Africa Green Agricultural Development Research Center, and a qualified institution for Chinese Government Scholarships. The university has launched cooperative education programs with the University of Camerino in Italy and Western Kentucky University in the United States; established the "China-Zambia College" at the University of Zambia for overseas education; and cooperated in establishing the Confucius Institute for Agricultural Science and Technology at the National University of Lesotho in Lesotho. It is the first provincial university in Jilin to conduct national-level foreign aid training and the first to carry out the overseas human resources training. The agricultural technology demonstration center in Zambia, built with the support of the university on behalf of China, is hailed as a "model of South-South cooperation."

The university covers an area of 1,325.03 hectares, including a campus area of 347.62 hectares and teaching and research bases of 977.41 hectares. The campus building area is 578,600 square meters, with total assets of 3.39 billion yuan. The library holds 1.8784 million paper books and 1.4169 million electronic books.



II. CATEGORIES OF APPLICANTS AND ELIGIBILITY

Doctoral degree students	Have Master's Degree, under the age of 55; Chinese Government Scholarship applicants should be under the age of 40
Master degree students	Have Bachelor Degree, under the age of 50; Chinese Government Scholarship applicants should be under the age of 35
Undergraduate Students	Applicants should have the equivalent of a senior high school degree in China, ranging from 18 years of age to 30 years of age (legal documents for legal guardians in China are required).
Senior Advanced Students	Having obtained a master's degree or above, he may, under the guidance of a professor of our university, apply for an appropriate extension of his term of one year in principle.
General Advanced Students	Undergraduate and master's degree students are required to take corresponding courses or study Chinese. Under 40 years of age, bachelor degree, major in further study.

IV. APPLICATION DOCUMENTS

1. Application Form for Jilin Agricultural University (written in Chinese or English) ;
2. Passport Copy
3. Notarized highest diploma; Prospective diploma recipients must submit official document issued by your current school to prove your current student status or expected graduation date. Documents in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
4. Academic transcripts (written in Chinese or English) ;
Transcripts in languages other than Chinese or English must be attached with notarized Chinese or English translations.
5. A Study Plan or Research Proposal (written in English) ; This should be a minimum of 800 words.
6. Two Recommendation Letters (written in Chinese or English) ; Applicants must submit two recommendation letters signed by a professor or an associate professor.
7. Students applying for a Chinese teaching major are required to provide: new HSK4 level 180 or above (if they do not have a HSK certificate, they may try it first); students applying for an English teaching major must meet at least one of the following conditions: native English; official English; major English; TOEFL 80 or above or IELTS 5.5
8. A copy of the Medical Examination Form for Foreigners. Go to the website <http://www.csc.edu.cn/laihua> or <http://www.campuschina.org> for download in English. Applicants should be examined in strict accordance with the items required in the Foreigner's Physical Examination Form. The Medical Examination Form for Foreigners with missing items, no personal photos or no seal on the photograph, no doctor or hospital signature is invalid. The inspection results are valid for 6 months;
